1 The Mission

The purpose of the Active Database Central (ADC) is to be the premier Internet resource on active database technology. The web site was opened in May 1997 and it has now received more than 3000 visitors. Current contents of the web site are:

- News. A forum for announcing new active database publications.
- Introduction. Information and links to general sources, such as conference and workshop proceedings, special issues of journals, and text books.
- Bibliographies. An annotated bibliography (updated version of [1]), and the ADC bibliography containing more than 315 references.
- Links to research groups and active database software.

2 Request for Submissions and Participation

In our effort to be the premier Internet resource, we seek submissions on the following topics:

- References. New or old references that are not already part of the ADC bibliography. The ADC bibliography focuses on active database publications (written in English) that have appeared in proceedings, books, journals, and references to Ph.D. theses.
- Lecture material. Powerpoint presentations, slides, assignments, etc.
- Software. All kinds of software that make use of active rules.

We also welcome participation from people that would like to take part in running and evolving the Active Database Central.
